Otherwise protect with fire blankets, quards, or metal shields.  $\sqrt{\phantom{a}}$ All wall and floor openings covered.  $\square$ Walkways protected beneath hot work. **WORK ON WALLS OR CEILINGS**  $\mathbf{\Lambda}$ Combustibles moved away from other side of wall. **WORK IN CONFINED SPACES** Confined space cleaned of all combustibles (example: grease, oil, flammable vapors). Containers purged of flammable liquids/vapors. Follow confined space guidelines. FIRE WATCH/HOT WORK AREA MONITORING Fire watch will be provided during and for 30 minutes after work, including any coffee or lunch breaks.  $\overline{\mathbf{Q}}$ Fire watch is supplied with an extinguisher, and/or water pump can, also making use of other extinguishers located throughout work area.  $\overline{\mathbf{V}}$ Fire watch is trained in use of this equipment and familiar with location of sounding alarm.
